Year Round Pell

Important Notice for Pell Grant Eligible Students

Effective with the 2017-18 award year, the Federal Pell Grant Program will allow a student to receive Pell Grant funds for up to 150 percent of a student Pell Grant Scheduled Award for an award year. A student may receive up to 50 percent of an additional Federal Pell Grant Scheduled Award within an award year for an additional semester attended (i.e. summer). This is referred to as "Year Round Pell".

To be eligible for the additional Pell Grant funds, the student must be otherwise eligible to receive Pell Grant funds for the summer payment period and <u>must be enrolled at least half-time</u> (6 credit hours).

For example, a student attends full-time fall and spring, fully utilizing the initial Scheduled Award of 100 percent. If the student attends summer full-time, the student may receive a full-time award, which would be an additional 50 percent of the Scheduled Award for the year.

Potential Issues

A change in your enrollment status could cause you to lose your Pell Grant Funds. If your enrollment drops to less than half-time; less than 6 credit hours; for the summer semester, you may lose eligibility for the Pell Grant listed on your award letter.

To receive the additional Pell Grant award, you must make academic progress by successfully completing classes during the academic year (2017-18), and be in good academic standing during the summer semester in which you receive the additional Pell Grant.

The Year Round Additional Pell Grant award will be included in the student's maximum 600% Pell Lifetime Eligibility Used in accordance with the Federal Pell Grant regulations.
