



ACCOUNTANTS ARE THE FINANCIAL BACKBONE OF A BUSINESS. They help people to conceive goals, plan how to achieve them and then take the necessary steps. They assemble and analyze essential information about financial operations. While we associate accountants with tax time, they work behind the scenes year-round.

What will I learn in the Accounting program?

You will learn accounting principles, theories and practice. You will study business law, finance, management and economics. You will also develop skills in communication, computer application, financial analysis and critical thinking. You will also learn ethics.

Will I be suited for this type of work?

If you like crunching numbers, have strong math skills and like handling money, then accounting is the career field for you. Because you are handling money, you must be trustworthy, disciplined and honest. You must also be task driven and detail oriented.

How long does it take to complete the program?

This program offers an associate degree and certificate in accounting and a certificate in accounting/bookkeeper. The degree can be completed in two years. Each certificate requires 18 credit hours, which can be completed in two semesters.

Can I complete this program online?

The certificate in accounting can be completed entirely online. Some accounting and business courses offered in the degree program can be completed online.

How much money can I make?

According to the Occupational Outlook Handbook from the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, the median national pay for bookkeeping, accounting and auditing clerks is \$35,170 per year, or \$16.91 per hour, depending on experience and geographical location. If you earn a bachelor's degree in accounting, you will almost double your earning potential! Accountants who earn their master's degree or attain professional recognition as a Certified Public Accountant (CPA) will have the best job prospects and earning potential.
