Comments: The North Carolina State Board of Nursing offers a Nurse Licensure Compact (NLC) agreement which allows mutual recognition of a nursing license with 43 jurisdictions for nurses trained in NC to practice in member states. ADN licensure requirements vary by state and other individual factors including credentials, training, job experience, criminal history or military service. Student applications are reviewed on a case-by-case basis. All ADN graduates will take a standardized exam (NCLEX) called NCLEX-RN.
