***While a human biology or anatomy and physiology with lab is ideal, the social work department can/will accept a natural science with a lab (as long as it is an approved transfer course – specifically ensuring it is not remedial).

- To graduate with a baccalaureate degree in social work from Mount Vernon Nazarene University, the student must have satisfactorily completed 120 semester hours. Students may transfer up to ½ of the courses in the major.
- MVNU will only accept transfer courses with a grade of C- or better.
- Social Work courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher.
- To begin and be conditionally or unconditionally accepted to the social work program, a student must have
 - completed 56 credit hours, completed 5 of 7 required foundation and cognate courses (excluding Biology and Statistics) have a minimum GPA of 3.0 (for conditional acceptance). One of the completed foundation courses must be Introduction to Social Work.
 - OR
 - completed 56 credit hours, completed all 7 required foundation and cognate courses (excluding Biology and Statistics) have a minimum GPA of 2.0 (for unconditional acceptance).
