**COURSE:** PMT 110 INTRO TO PROJECT MANAGEMENT

### COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course introduces project management fundamentals and principles for organizing, planning, implementing, and controlling non-routine activities to achieve schedule, budget and performance objectives. Topics include project life cycles; work breakdown structures; responsibility matrixes; as well as planning and control methods such as PERT/CPM and Gantt charts. Upon completion, students should be able demonstrate knowledge, strategies, and techniques needed to create and execute plans for project development and management.
