Steps to Qualify

- Submit a Request for Information form.
- Apply and be accepted to Campbell as a transfer student.
- Maintain a "C" or better in courses you wish to transfer.
- Enroll at Campbell within one year of completing your associate degree from RichmondCC.


RichmondCC Receives \$10,000 Grant to Help People Improve Their Digital and Technology Skills
