### Register Your Classes on Self-Service

1. Login to **Self-Service**.
2. Select Student Planning and then Go to Plan & Schedule.
3. Search for the course you need to schedule and then view available sections.
4. Choose the section you want by selecting Add Section to Schedule.
5. Once you have added all of your courses to your planned schedule, go back to Plan & Schedule and click on Advising.
6. Select Request Review to send your advisor notice to review and approve your planned classes.
7. After your advisor has reviewed your courses, you will receive an email. Go back to your planned schedule in Self-Service and register the courses by selecting Register Now.

## Getting into NC State Just Got Easier for You

**WOLFPACK CONNECT** provides a guaranteed admissions pathway to NC State for RichmondCC students. Students in the program who earn an associate's degree, maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher and meet NC State's transfer admission deadlines can enroll in more than 100 eligible NC State majors and concentrations.

Wolfpack Connect is open to students of any income level and does not require North Carolina residency. Additionally, through this partnership, RichmondCC students can take NC State courses while completing their associate degree, giving them an early start on their university studies.

## UNCP Transfer Opportunity for Social and Human Services Grads

RichmondCC students who have completed the Social & Human Services Technology associate degree can now transfer into the Bachelor of Science in Social Work program at the University of North Carolina-Pembroke.

RichmondCC students can transfer up to 90 credits, leaving approximately 30 credits to complete at UNC Pembroke.

As an undergraduate student at UNC Pembroke, students will benefit from the NC Promise tuition rates, paying only \$500 per semester for in-state tuition and \$2,500 for out-of-state tuition.


