

RichmondCC students confront a variety of obligations that conflict with their educational goals. Currently about 20% of RichmondCC students do not receive any sort of financial assistance. For many students, the lack of funds coupled with competing work and family responsibilities will prolong their time in school or even cause them to drop out. The RichmondCC Working Scholarship is designed to help ease that burden so students can complete their degree

Application Criteria

Students must submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at www.fafsa.ed.gov

Students must submit a RichmondCC Working Student Scholarship application each semester

Students and/or family members must verify employment by submitting a recent payroll stub or a letter, on letterhead, from their employer stating the hours worked.

Only students who are not eligible for full federal or state grants are eligible for this scholarship.

Eligible students and/or family member must be employed at least 10 hours a week.

Student must have a GPA of 2.0 or higher.

Awards

Full-time (12 credit hours or more) eligible for \$500

Three-quarter time (9-11 credit hours) eligible for \$350

Half-time (6-8 credit hours) eligible for \$250

Awards are available to view on Self-Service.

The financial aid committee will request your attendance at the annual scholarship banquet to be held in the spring of each year.
