

Checklist for Research Paper

- □ Is the title informative and appropriate?
- □ Is the thesis statement clear? Is the organization logical? If headings are used, do they follow the appropriate format?
- □ Are tone, voice, and diction appropriate?
- □ Are transitions smooth from sentence to sentence, paragraph to paragraph, and section to section?
- □ Are credible sources and evidence used? Is the supporting material suitable and persuasive? Does is adequately support the thesis?
- Are quotes paraphrased and summarized passages properly introduced with a single phrase?
- □ Are visual materials introduced before they appear in the text?
- □ Are long quotes set off from the text?
- □ Is proper credit given to sources throughout?
- Does the paper consistently adhere to the style assigned by your instructor?
- □ (MLA APA, Chicago, etc...) in format and in the documentation, both within the text and in a reference list or list of works cited?
- □ Were the instructions for assignment length, number, and kinds of resources to be used, directions for title page, or documentation, followed carefully?
